Do Mandatory	Don't Mandatory
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wear your mask at all times while on the College premises. • Keep a distance of 1.5 metres between yourself and other people. • Wash your hands frequently for 20+ seconds with soap and clean running water. • If soap and water is not available, use sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. • When coughing and sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with a handkerchief or tissue. Dispose of the used handkerchief or tissue in a closed bin. • Exercise patience with mandatory work, you shall be assisted shortly. • Report to the Covid-19 Representative person on site if you (students or staff) should feel sick on campus. • Learn about symptoms of COVID-19. • Do self-screening daily on the HealthCheck APP. • Regularly wipe surfaces that are frequently touched (door handles, chairs, tables, computers, and cellphones). • Always follow protocols. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand to hand contact or hugging. • Touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands. • Touch high-touched surfaces in public places • Don't travel if you experience any symptoms of COVID-19. • Don't share stationary with other students/colleagues. • Don't come to campus when you have chronic illnesses or pregnant. • Don't smoke within the premises of Maluti TVET College (students and lecturers).
