Residence Based Protocols

- The students should be prioritized according to the timetable and the prioritized subjects, to stay within the government regulation of 33%.
- Each student residence needs a COVID 19 response team that include screening volunteers.
- The Residence Management will take the lead in the screening after being capacitated by the HIGHER HEALTH team.

1. Screening Team

- The screening teams should ensure that all people within the residences are screened daily, and where persons display symptoms, they should be linked to testing as well as being instructed to self-isolate within their rooms or a residence sickbay.

2. Cutleries

- Sharing of cutleries should be prohibited
- Each student advised to use their own cutleries.

3. Hostel venues

- Showers should be fitted with spray-based sanitizers for use before and after showering.
- Toilets should be fitted with sanitizers.
- Hallways should have hand sanitizers
- Toilets to be cleaned with water and bleach solution each start of the day and end of the day.
- The ideal number per room is 1 person but, in the instance, where it's 2 people in the room then the space of 2 metres should be observed and a solution of Bleach & Water or Handy Andy & water should be used on all surfaces. Should one of the students fall ill then the student needs to be moved to sickbay and testing be arranged.

4. Social distancing

- Social distancing should be upheld at all times.
- Masks should be worn at all times when in the public area.
- Roving teams should be visible at all times at the residences.
- Curfews should be implemented.
